Fire	-Faulty equipment -Open fire place -Cooking -Electrical Fault	-Ensure all equipment is checked regularly by qualified person -Never leave fire unguarded -Ensure fire extinguishers are available and in good working order -Ensure all students are aware of the location of alarms and escape routes	-Evacuate building -Raise alarm -Ensure all students are accounted for -Remain at a safe distance until further information given by authorities -Inform parents and school
Safety of Students	-Easy access to accommodation from outside -Poor security of accommodation -Other users of accommodation	-Ensure accommodation is secure -Ensure students are aware of how to deal with any inappropriate behaviour -Ensure students do not put themselves in dangerous situations -Ensure students are aware of the location of the adults and staff -Ensure any items of value are secured	-Ensure safety of students -Call emergency services if required -Apply first aid if required -Report any incidents to operators and police -Inform parents and school
General Safety	-Poor upkeep of facilities -Lack of emergency equipment -Poor signs -Lack of escape route -Poor understanding of safety issues	-Carry out pre-visit inspection of accommodation -Ensure all escapes are clear, well signed and safe -Ensure all students are aware of the nearest escape point -Ensure a procedure is set up to account for all students	-Check student welfare -Call emergency services if required -Inform parents and school
